Citation Formatting Guidelines

Please identify the location of sources in your publications, papers, footnotes, bibliographies, and websites. Proper citation is essential for the following reasons:

- To credit the sources used in your research.
- To facilitate the ability to track down these sources for potential future research by you or other researchers.

For Archival or Photographic collections please provide the following info:

Format: Accession Number and/or Name, Box #, Folder heading, Repository name

Examples:

- Accession #1, Fair Lane Papers, Box 42, Henry Ford – Awards and Tributes. Benson Ford Research Center, The Henry Ford.
- Accession #1660, Box 19, Assembly Line Methods – Automobiles – Ford Motor Co. - Michigan – Dearborn (Rouge) – 1928 to 1931. Benson Ford Research Center, The Henry Ford.
- General Photograph Collection, Box 19, Circus & Shows. Photo# P.92.31.6. Benson Ford Research Center, The Henry Ford.
- Accession 65, Ford Motor Company Oral Reminiscences, Fred Black. Benson Ford Research Center, The Henry Ford.
